23/06 | School Council Presentation

The School Council provided a presentation to the governors explaining the role of the council, its structure and some of the projects they have been involved in. They also shared ideas of future projects they would like to coordinate. The governors thanked the School Council and Mrs Waters for attending the meeting and said that it had been extremely valuable and that they enjoyed listening to their presentation.

Mrs Waters and the School Council left the meeting at 4.20pm.

23/07 Headteacher's Report

The Headteacher gave the following verbal report:

Attendance

Whole school attendance is improving and is currently 95.3%. The attendance of the 19 FSM pupils is 91.8% and the 20 combined FSM and Ever 6 pupils is 92.1%. Overall attendance for the 26 PPG pupils is 92.7%. There are currently 67 pupils with attendance under 90%, of which 20 are under 85%. These pupils are being closely monitored and parents are sent letters or invited in to meet with the Headteacher. The school is also having termly meetings with the allocated

Education Welfare Officer to discuss cases of particular concern. In the Autumn Term, the school began tracking pupils who are persistently late in the mornings and those who are persistently collected late at the end of the day. These parents are also being sent monitoring letters and being invited in for meetings.

Behaviour

The Headteacher said that there have been a significant amount of behaviour incidents involving specific children with high needs and that Senior Leaders have been spending a lot of time managing and supporting these situations. The Headteacher updated the governors on the financial implications of the additional agencies the school is using to support some of the children and a discussion was held regarding this funding and how it will affect the school budget moving forward. The school have asked for an early review meeting with WBC to discuss funding these children.

The governors asked if there is financial help available from any charities/third parties who may be able to support these pupils.

The school answered that there is nothing available for individual children.

Special Educational Needs and Disabilities

There are 46 pupils who are receiving SEN support in the school and 10 who have EHCPs. The school is buying in to a lot of external support from Speech Therapists, the Education Psychology Team, Foundry, ARC Counselling, Addington Outreach and the Mental Health Programme.

Safeguarding

There have been four safeguarding alerts since the last report.

e-Safety

There has been one e-safety alert.

Children In Care

There are currently no children in care.

23/08 SIDP

The Headteacher said that writing has been the main focus this term and that it has been extremely positive and lovely to see the passion and enthusiasm of the teachers. The staff are very well skilled to teach writing to a high standard and it is hoped that this will come through in the data.

The school is still practicing using the Therapeutic Thinking Approach, however, it has not been possible to complete any further training this term.

The new Master Reader programme is being implemented next term to work alongside Read Write Inc.

Whistleblowing

This policy was unanimously agreed and approved by the governors.

Virtual Governance

The governors recommended a change to Section 1.3 which states that all Full Governing Body and Committee meetings will be face to face. Since the pandemic, this is no longer the case and the policy will be amended to reflect that Committee meetings are now held virtually.

Section 2.1: A governor challenged if a note should be added that meetings should not take place on public transport, however, it was agreed that some governors need to access meetings whist they are travelling by train. It was agreed that they may continue to do so as long as they assess their surroundings and are confident that other commuters are unable to hear the conversations being held.

It was reiterated that a policy proforma completed by a governor prior to a meeting does not act as a vote of approval under any circumstances.

With the above amendment made, this policy was unanimously agreed and approved by the governors.
