## **SUBJECT INTENT**

At The Hawthorns, our art curriculum intends to engage, inspire and challenge pupil's creativity, as well as self-expression and giving them opportunities to connect with others. It enables our children, of all abilities, to communicate what they see, feel and think through the use of colour, texture, form, pattern and different materials and processes. As pupils progress, they should be able to think critically and develop a more rigorous understanding of art and design. We hope to foster a lifelong love of art by exposing them to a wide range of artist experiences and igniting a passion for art.

# **CULTURAL CAPITAL**

### The essential knowledge that children need to be educated citizens

At The Hawthorns, Art is cross-curricular and links strongly with the topics being studied in each year group. We provide our children with high-quality art and design education that engages, inspires and challenges pupils, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to experiment, invent and create their own works of art, craft and design. In Art, pupils learn about a range of well-known artists and study their work and their lives. In addition, we organise a number of art competitions and projects that allow children to develop their art skills. To promote Art opportunity further we provide Art club and have an 'Art exhibition' at the end of the year. We also have art displays covering the classrooms and hallways as well as a 'Hawthorns Gallery' which shows progression through the year groups. We aim to enable pupils to progress in such a way, that allows for the development of critical thinking and a rigorous understanding of art and design. Through all the things that children love to do, we ensure that young people don't just experience the arts and culture but that they actively take part and create their own as participants. At The Hawthorns we bring an awareness of how art and design both reflects and shapes our history, and contributes to the culture, creativity and wealth of our nation.

### **IMPLEMENTATION**

At Hawthorns Primary both KS1 and KS2 follow the National Curriculum 2014 set out for Art. The Art learning starts in reception, where children learn to safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function, through a combination of child initiated and adult directed activities. The learning of Art is based around the early learning goals 'Expressive Arts and Design, Understanding the World and Physical Development'. These skills are then build on throughout the year groups in our threshold concepts and milestones. Our curriculum is designed to ensure progression is achieved and we ensure we build on children's knowledge, understanding and skills throughout each year groups. Each key stage focuses on different themes to ensure continued interest in the subject as well as acquiring new knowledge. Our children are taught how art and design both reflect and shape our history, and contribute to the culture, creativity and wealth of our nation. Children at Hawthorns are taught that Art is not a stand-alone topic, it is cross curricular and can be integrated across all areas of the curriculum.

#### **IMPACT**

At The Hawthorns, Art is embedded within our Hawthorns vision. The subject is cross curricular and draws upon subject knowledge and skills within other areas of the curriculum.

At The Hawthorns we strive for:

- Art and design learning to be loved by all pupils.
- All children in school to be able to speak confidently about their art and design work and their skills.
- All children to be able to use technical vocabulary accurately and pupils are expected to know, apply and understand the matters, skills and processes specified

- All children to improve their enquiry skills and inquisitiveness about the world around them, and their impact through art and design on the world.
