

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will secure our place value knowledge up to 1000, recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number (100s, 10s, 1s), compare and order numbers up to 1,000, identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, as well as read and write numbers up to 1,000 in numerals and in words.

English

As writers we will be writing instruction texts and creating a persuasive advert using How to wash a Woolly Mammoth and Ug. In the second half of the term, we will be writing fantasy stories and descriptions linked to the Firework Maker's Daughter.

Master Reader

As readers, we will study The Owl who was afraid of the Dark and The Firework Maker's Daughter.

French

French will be based on Cave languages scheme of work for Year 3. We will be learning greetings, classroom commands, colours and investigating Christmas traditions in France. Both rhymes and songs will be used to support our learning and we will look at French grammar and phonics. (nouns, verbs, etc).

History

As Historians we will be looking at the changes in Britain through the Stone Age, Bronze Age and into the Iron Age. We will be comparing lifestyles and developments using chronological points as reference.
