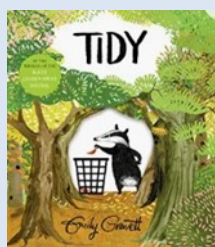
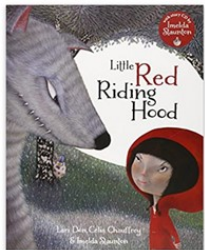


Mathematics

We will be focusing on place value and learn to confidently recognise what each digit represents in a two-digit number (tens and ones). We will use our place value knowledge and number fact knowledge to solve problems and to explain our reasoning. We will use a range of methods to add and subtract two-digit numbers.

English

We will be continuing our excellent start to reading by introducing the children to Master Readers. We will read daily and discuss the text in depth. We will be taking part in creative writing to describe a wolf, create adverts for litter picking and a diary entry about what William sees at night. We will start to learn the Year 2 spelling rules—the ones we are covering will be shared via Spelling Shed each week. In handwriting we will be recapping all of the joins and practising writing out our spelling words in a cursive script.

Geography

We will be using maps and the internet to locate different woodlands and plotting them on a map. We will design our own woodland park, draw a map and create a key for it. We will be learning the 4 countries that make up the United Kingdom and will be comparing local woodlands to jungles.

Religious Education

This term we will be learning more about Christianity. In the first half term the children will be exploring what Jesus taught with a link to kindness. In the second half term, the children will be exploring 'Why do Christians see Jesus as the light of the world?' We will also retell the Christmas story in our production.

Computing

This term, we will learn to log on to the laptops and to access the Purple Mash website to practise key skills.

We will be focusing on e-safety, effective searching as well as creating pictures which are influenced by a range of artists and techniques.

PSHE

We will be focusing on 'Being Me in My Own World' and 'Celebrating Difference'. We will discuss our hopes and our rights and responsibilities in the first half term before focusing on accepting that everyone is different and the importance of being kind.

Science

We will be learning all about woodland animals and the woodlands as a habitat. We will learn about food chains and about animals and their offspring.

Art and DT

We will be designing and making our own clay woodland creature and a shoebox woodland habitat. We will be exploring the artist Andy Goldworthy and how he uses natural resources to make art. We will be exploring how we can use resources such as leaves, bark etc. to print and make art ourselves.
