

THE HAWTHORNS PRIMARY SCHOOL CYCLE SAFETY

Cycle safety is just as important as learning to cross the road.

- 1. All cyclists should wear a properly fitted cycle helmet.
- 2. Be seen. Consider reflective clothing, strips and /or lights on your bicycle.
- 3. All cycles must be in a roadworthy condition.
- 4. Be heard, consider having a bell to let other people know you are there.
- 5. Control your speed on pavements and anywhere near roads.
- 6. Be aware of other people. Do not push past or weave in and out of others.
- 7. Stop at the kerb and be aware of driveways.
- 8. Cyclists must ride sensibly and follow the Highway Code.
- 9. Younger children should always be accompanied by an adult.
- 10. Remember the Green Cross Code. STOP, LOOK, LISTEN.

School provision.

- 11. All cycles must be locked securely in the approved cycle parking area.
- 12. You must dismount when entering the school grounds, and at all times walk the cycle while within the school grounds.
- 13. While the school provides the cycle storage facility, loss or damage to the cycle **is not** covered by the school insurance policy and therefore cycles are left at the owners own risk.
- 14. At present the school has 16 cycle rack places available for the use by pupils.

No electrical cycles are to be used for travel to and from school.
